
Testicular cancer can be cured if found early.

Who gets this kind of cancer?

- Men of all ages can get this cancer but it is most common at ages 15-35 years.
- Males who had testicles that did not move down into the scrotum (sac) at birth have a greater chance of getting testicular cancer.

Check yourself. Here's how.

- Check by rolling the testicles gently between your thumbs (on top) and index/middle fingers (on bottom).
- The best time to check is just after a warm shower.
- You should not feel any pain when doing the exam.
- Do not worry if one testicle feels
 larger than the other. That is normal. There is also a soft tubelike
 structure behind the testicles which may feel lumpy but is not
 testicular cancer.



Tell your doctor if you have:

- A swelling or lump in the testicles.
- Changes in the size or feeling of the testicles.
- A heavy feeling in the scrotum (sac that holds the testicles).
- A dull ache in the lower abdomen, back, or groin (the area above the thigh).
- Pain or discomfort in the testicles or scrotum.

These symptoms can be caused by cancer or by other conditions. It is important to see a doctor if you have any of the above.
